Election procedures

An election under section 17(3)(a) of the Act must be held at each AGM to fill the elected Board member positions that are vacant. Only a full (practising) or non-practising registrant in good standing is eligible to vote in the election. A registrant who is eligible to vote in an election is entitled to one (1) ballot and may vote for one (1) candidate for each Board position to be filled in the election. Voting is by secret ballot.
